History

In its sleek-designed bottle, showcasing the Pyrenees, Alta is the result of meticulous selection of high-altitude terroirs (the coolest ones) from the foothills of the Pyrenees. Harvested at night to preserve primary aromas, Alta stands out for its lightness and balance, satisfying rosé enthusiasts year-round by offering them a unique tasting experience.

Vineyard

Parcel selection from terroirs with later ripening to preserve freshness and aromas.

Grape varieties

60% Malbec, 20% Syrah, 20% Cinsault

Vinification

Each grape variety is vinified separately through direct pressing, followed by controlled fermentation at 15°C. The different grape varieties are then blended through a lengthy tasting process to achieve the perfect balance.

Tasting notes

Its clarity and brightness lead us to a bouquet of citrus, dominated by grapefruit notes. On the palate, it reveals itself as light, subtle, offering a fresh and elegant experience.

Food pairing

Whether enjoyed as an aperitif, paired with a cocktail salad, Asian dishes such as Thai cuisine, or during a relaxed evening with tapas, our Alta rosé adapts to all occasions and seasons.
