Panorama is a survey of our great high-altitude terroirs and their grape varieties. This range is the expression of parcel selections from our hillside plots in the Upper Aude Valley. Born on the heights of Roquetaillade, this wine captures the essence of our high-altitude vineyard, with the imposing Pyrenees range as a backdrop. A true Panorama!

Vineyard

Our parcels, cultivated using organic farming methods, are located on clay-limestone soils from our high-altitude terroir in the Upper Aude Valley.

Vinification

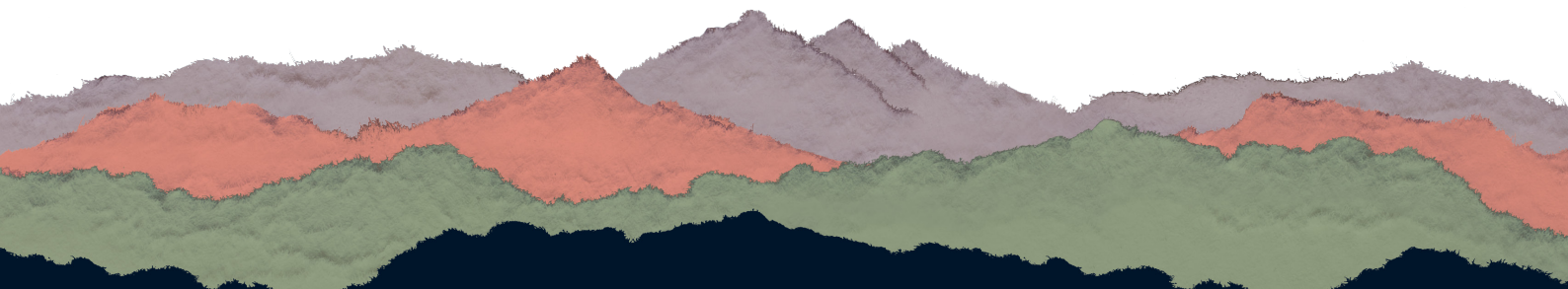
This Chardonnay is obtained through the most natural winemaking methods possible to allow the terroir's typicity to shine through. It undergoes cold settling, controlled temperature fermentation, and then a light 4-month aging process in barrels.

Tasting notes

A lively and upfront attack, with floral aromatic notes that satisfy the desire for a white wine combining freshness and finesse. Serving temperature: 9 to 11°C.

Food pairing

Whether as an aperitif or paired with fish boasting delicate iodized flavors, this Chardonnay will also enhance the end of your meal with characterful cheeses such as goat cheese, pelardon, rocamadour, parmesan, or even a baked camembert.
